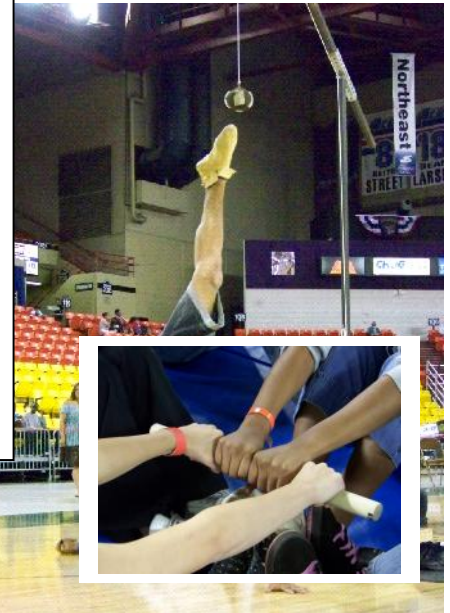

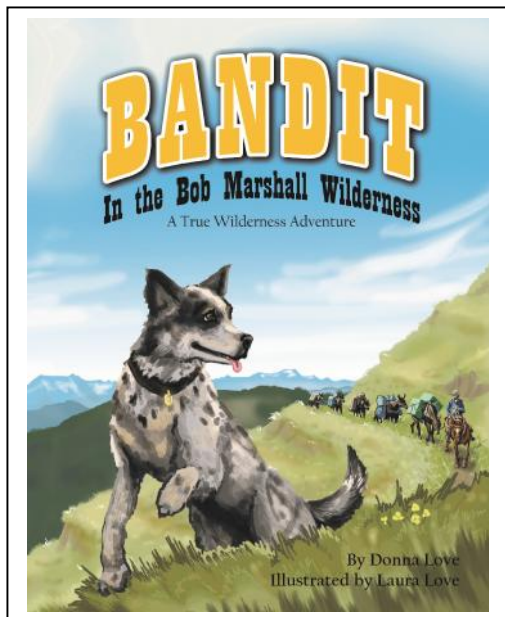

*(Add lodging if overnight required for program.)*

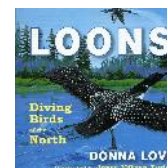
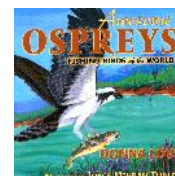
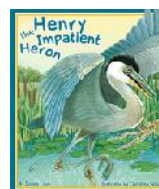
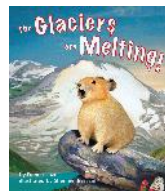
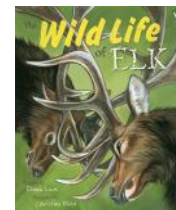
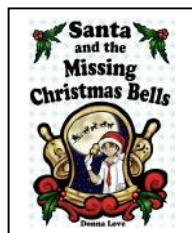
